KOSCIUSKO RALLY - FACTS & FIGURES - Bill Searl, Treasurer

The rally was financially very successful for the Club as shown by these figures -

- 304 prepaid entries were received
- 40 of these people did not turn up
- 224 badges were sold at the rally
- 500 people (approx.) came to the rally
 - 37 T-shirts were screen printed
- \$2,477 was received from badge and screen print sales
- \$1,394 was spent by the club on the rally
- \$1,083 is the overall profit.

It is intended to invest some of this money in a term deposit account for next year's rally. Also the Club is investigating the cost of its own badges/stickers. Some of you may have other ideas?

As our rally badges next year will cost a little less we are in a strong position to make the 1983 Kosciusko Rally even better than this one.
