

NEW BMW HELMET

The BMW Mk II helmet has been released for sale in Australia. The Mk II has many of the features pioneered by the 'system' helmet as well as improved aerodynamics and a unique ventilation system resulting in improved levels of safety and comfort and reduced wind noise. Air is ducted via an adjustable inlet in the chin piece around both sides of the visor to exit near the rider's temple in order to provide ventilation and reduce visor misting. The helmet is crafted from fibreglass and polystyrene padding with leather and velour lining and complies with the latest Australian standards (AS1698 &AS1609). Colours available are the familiar white and silver schemes of the previous range and a number of alternative visors, neck cushions and chin guards are available. All this for just \$299.

HEATED HANDGRIPS

There are still three sets of the heated grips ordered by the club available to members.

Price of a bit of winter comfort is only \$35 (price them elsewhere).

NEW BMW R100RS.

The new model appears to be very much a mix of 'K' series and 'R' series technology like the current R80 range available here.

The Queensland BMW Club is promoting their tenth anniversary Cane Toad Rally at Easter, this year (April 17-20).


The rally is to be held "on private property on the banks of a crystal clear mountain stream within walking distance of Finch Hatton gorge National Park, 60km west of Mackay."




 Mother and child are both well, Ellen said four is enough, Geoff probably agrees whose turn to feed at 3am????

Next month (March $^{\rm Q}$) is the Annual General Meeting and there are a few points that members should keep in mind about this meeting.

- 1. Only current financial members will be able to vote in the elections for the new committee. This means that you must pay the 1987/198% fees prior to the election.
- 2. In order for the AGM (and elections) to proceed there must be 25% of the financial membership present, so please make an effort to turn up.
- Nominations for committee positions may be presented, in writing, to the Secretary prior to the AGM and must be signed by the proposer, seconder and the nominee.

 All must be financial members. Nominations may also be accepted at the AGM provided that the proposer, seconder and nominee are all present.
- 4. Proxy votes may be accepted from financial members and must be in writing and signed by both the proxy and member concerned.
- Notices of motion to change any aspect of the Constitution may be presented at the AGM, and will require a 2/3 majority vote to be passed.

As financial members your interest and participation in the AGM is essential and you should consider nominations for the Committee positions outlined below.

PRESIDENT

The President is required to chair the General Meetings and oversee the operation of the Committee and the Club from both a business and social point of view and may be required to act as spokesperson for the Club.

VICE PRESIDENT

Assists and deputises for the President. May be required to chair meetings.

SECRETARY

Required to keep Minutes of general and committee meetings, attend to correspondence and keep track of Club property.

TREASURER

Required to keep track of Club finances, collect and pay monies and keep financial records in appropriate order.

SOCIAL SECRETARY


Organises social meetings and runs as necessary.

EDITOR & COMMITTEE

Editor is required to compile and layout the monthly journal and supervise three other committee members who arrange printing, typing and distribution.

RALLY COORDINATOR
